

# Beef & Veggie Dog Biscuits



These dog treats have lots of the flavors your pets love without any chemicals or preservatives

| 3c whole wheat flour             | 1 1/2c beef broth (I use<br>Wyler's sodium~free<br>instant) | 1/4c molasses              |
| 1c yellow corn meal              |   | 1/2c dried apples, chopped |
| 1c rolled oats                   | 1/2c corn oil   | 1/3c carrot, shredded      |
| 2/3c powdered nonfat dry<br>milk | 3 large eggs, divided use                                   |                            |

Preheat oven to 350. Mix together whole wheat flour, corn meal, oats and dry milk in large bowl.

Mix together beef broth, corn oil, 2 eggs and molasses. Add dried apples and carrot and mix well. Add wet mixture into dry mixture and mix well. Dough should be firm.

Let dough sit for 20~30 minutes. On a lightly floured surface, roll out dough 1/4" thick and cut into desired shapes.

Beat remaining egg in small bowl and, using a pastry brush, brush cut shapes with egg wash. Bake 25~35 minutes or until golden brown. Turn off oven, leaving cookie sheets in while biscuits cool.

#### Prepare Ahead Tip

Store in air~tight container in refrigerator for up to 4 weeks.
