

Tuna Cat Treats

Makes about 60

1/2c whole wheat flour

1/2c nonfat, dry, powdered milk

1/2 can tuna in oil

1T vegetable oil

1 egg, beaten

1/4c water

2T catnip ~ optional *

Preheat oven to 350 and spray cookie sheets with non~stick cooking spray.

In large bowl, mash tuna into smaller pieces. Add flour and milk. Mix well. Add water and oil and mix well.

Beat egg in separate dish until it gets a foamy texture. Add to mix. The dough will be sticky. Using your fingers, shape into small bite~sized balls about the size of a marble. Put balls on cookie sheets and flatten with your hand.

Bake 10 minutes.

Remove treats from oven, let sit 5 minutes then turn treats over and bake 10 more minutes.

Remove from oven and allow to cool completely before giving to your cat. Store in airtight container in refrigerator.

* Catnip can be added into the dough or can be sprinkled on top of the treats just before baking.
