

Homemade Doggie Treats



These doggie treats are much better for Fido than the store bought kind and they'll last forever in your pantry

Makes 20 treats

1c rolled oats	2T sodium~free chicken bouillon powder
1/3c margarine	1/2c milk
1c water, boiling	4oz cheddar cheese, shredded
3/4c cornmeal	1 egg
1T sugar	2~3c whole wheat flour

Preheat oven to 325. Line 2 rimmed baking sheets with parchment paper.

In large bowl, combine oats, margarine and water. Let stand 10 minutes. With mixer dough hook running, stir in cornmeal, sugar, bouillon, milk, cheese and egg. Mix well.

Add flour 1c at a time, mixing well after each addition to form a stiff dough. On floured surface, knead until dough is smooth, 3~4 minutes.

Roll out to 1/2" thickness and cut with doggie bone cookie cutter. Place 1" apart on cookie sheets.

Bake 35~45 minutes until golden brown.

Variations:

Substitute beef or fish bouillon or substitute peanut butter for cheddar cheese.
