

Homemade Doggie Treats



They're extremely easy to make, much better for your pet than the store~bought biscuits and they're a lot less expensive than the national brands

Makes approximately 36

2c whole wheat flour	2T vegetable oil
1/2c corn meal	1/2c smooth peanut butter
1t sodium~free instant beef granules	2 large eggs
2t bone meal	1/4c beef broth

Preheat oven to 350. Spray 2 cookie sheets with non~stick cooking spray. Combine dry ingredients in large bowl. Add oil and peanut butter. Whisk together eggs and beef broth in small bowl and add to remaining ingredients. Mix well.

Knead dough for 3 minutes until it holds together, adding additional beef broth if the dough is too stiff. Allow dough to rest 30 minutes. Roll dough out to 1/2" thickness on lightly floured surface.

Cut into shapes with cookie cutters or knife. Place 1" apart on cookie sheets. Bake 30 minutes, or until golden brown. Allow biscuits to dry overnight. Store in air~tight container.

Prepare Ahead Tip

These doggie treats will last well at room temperature for about 2 weeks. For longer storage, store in air~tight container in refrigerator.

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
